1. Introduction

This document provides a description of the installation procedure of the IUCLID 5 migration tool for Windows and Linux.

2. How to Install the Migration Plug-in

2.1. Check Your Migration Version

In the IUCLID 5 Task Panel, select About from the Help menu on the menu bar. In the new window which appears, select the tab "Installed Plugins". Under the Plugin ID column, select the file "eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.migration.MigrationToolPlugin" and check the version number under the tab Version. If the version is 5.0.0, you should download and update your Migration Tool.

2.2. How to Download the Migration Tool

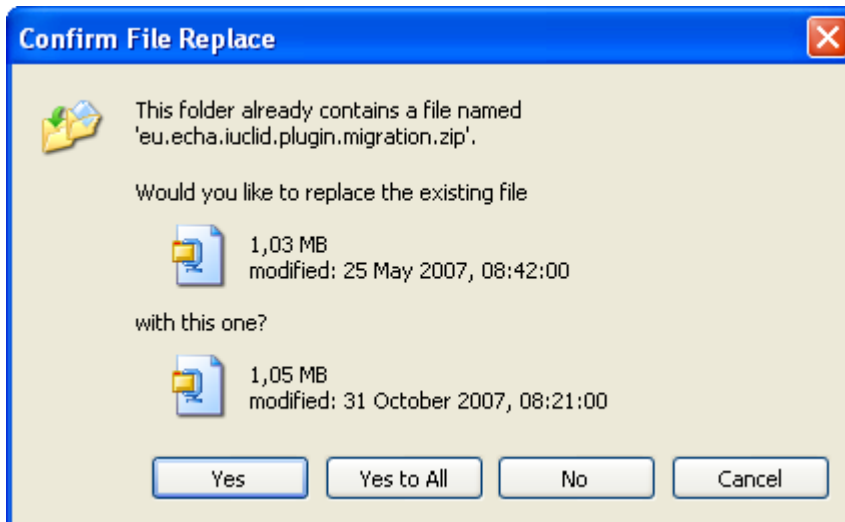
Open your internet browser, for example Internet Explorer,

- Go to the IUCLID 5 download website <http://iuclid.eu>.
- Log into the restricted section of the download website with your previously created userID and password.
- Select "Download", "Migration Tool". Click on "[Download the installation package](#)".
- Select "I acknowledge", select "Next", accept the license agreement, and select "I am entitled to sign this License agreement", select "Next", Select "please click here" to start the download. Select "Save" to save the file to your computer.
- Extract the migration tool "**eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.migration.zip**" from the file "IUCLID5_migration_2007-12-17.zip" that you downloaded. Use the file **eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.migration.zip** for the rest of the installation.
- To complete the installation, select the "Workstation installation" or the "Server installation" section of this document, depending on your current IUCLID 5 installation.

2.3. Workstation Installation

If IUCLID 5 is running, stop the application.

- Copy the file "**eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.migration.zip**" into the "workstation\plugins" folder.
- A popup message will appear:



- Answer “Yes to all”.
- Restart IUCLID 5.

After logging into IUCLID 5, check the Migration Tool’s version number again to ensure that it is 5.1.2.

2.4. Server Installation

- Copy the file “eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.migration.zip” into the “\webapps\i5server\i5clientPlugins\remotePlugins” folder.
- If you receive a message asking whether you would like to replace the existing file of the same name, answer yes. You may also receive a message stating that the digital signature of the application cannot be verified. Select that you “Always trust content from this publisher”, if you do not want this message to re-appear, and select “Run”.

After logging into IUCLID 5, check the version number of the Migration Tool again to ensure that it is 5.1.2.

2.5. Checking for a Successful Installation

If the installation was successful, the migration plug-in should be added to the task panel, the tool bar and also the menu-bar (“Plug-ins| Migrate”).

If the installation was successful, the version number of the Migration Tool's version number should be 5.1.2

3. Release Notes

3.1. Overview

The purpose of this Migration Tool Release Notes is to give an overview of changes and improvements applied to the IUCLID 5 Migration Tool.

The first release of the Migration Tool is dated June 12th 2007. This Migration Tool is included in all IUCLID 5 packages available at <http://iuclid.eu> and is also available as a plug-in file.

The new release of the IUCLID Migration Tool (covered by these Release Notes) improve the overall user experience when migrating data from IUCLID 4 to IUCLID 5; in addition a number of issues identified with the old version were addressed and solved.

The IUCLID 5 Service Desk recommends installing the new release urgently, as not doing so will result in possible data inconsistency.

3.2. List of Modifications

- Creating tables in html areas pre-filled with migrated text is now possible.
- No exception when switching the decimal separator from "point" to "comma".
- No failure when migrating incomplete chapters 10.1, 10.2 and 10.3 from IUCLID 4.
- No exception when endpoints contain fractional sort numbers of different lengths.
- No exception when CAS or EINECS number are missing.
- Links to attachments within the endpoint content are correctly generated
 - Data migrated with the previous IUCLID 5 migration tool needs to be corrected.
- Remarks to attachments are correctly migrated
 - Data migrated with the previous IUCLID 5 migration tool needs to be corrected.
- Qualifiers (<, =, >, etc.) migrate correctly also when no lower value present in IUCLID 4 data.
- Attachments to Reference Substances are now migrated without causing occasional exceptions when they are already present in the database.
- Distribution soil values are now checked against their format mask, limits and field capacity.
- Migration tool now accepts files with extension ".EXP" in uppercase.
- The decimal values are conformed to their format mask
- The references to endpoints within a template object are sorted by their IUC4 Sort number or its chapter number.
- When an IUCLID4 chapter has several potential target chapters in IUCLID5 and an attachment is linked to this endpoint, the relation is now properly established.
- Units for values are migrated also if no qualifier is used.
- Industry category is migrated correctly.
 - Data migrated with the previous IUCLID 5 migration tool might be missing information in the industry category.
- IUCLID 4 chapters 5.10 "Exposure experience" and 5.11. "Additional information" migrated correctly
 - Data migrated with the previous IUCLID 5 migration tool might be missing information from IUCLID4 chapters 5.10. and 5.11. when the "Type" field was not filled.
- Exception has been corrected when m (measured) is selected instead of c (calculated).
- Logging/reporting of fraction digit changes has been added. When values with too many fractional digits are (correctly) rounded to the next available valid value in the i5z file, there is an entry in the migration report tracking this.

3.3. Release Coordination

This new release includes announcements in the IUCLID 5 website (<http://iuclid.eu>) and it will be included in all 4 packages available for download:

Standalone packages

- Workstation - IUCLID5_Setup-Kit_20070601
- Workstation - standalone_manual_2007_06_01

Distributed packages

- Server - distributed_linux_2007-06-01
- Server – Manual_distributed_2007_06_01

The new Migration Tool v5.1.2 is also available for downloading separately on the Download section in the IUCLID 5 website <http://iuclid.eu>.

The License Agreement acknowledged during the download of the original software applies to this updated release, according to the relevant paragraph:

The use of the Software is not restricted to a specific national, regional or international legal requirement. The Software means also all of the contents of the files (provided either by electronic download, on physical media or any other method of distribution), disk(s), CD-ROM(s) or other media with which this Agreement is provided, **as well as any updated versions of the above-mentioned computer software.**
