Fixed Bugs

Use of the translated HelpSystem plug-ins – post-digit values

Wrong decimal separator was written into the database if the system language was not English. Post digit values might have been lost or truncated when the language was changed to a language setting (e.g. to German) that uses a different decimal separator as the English language setting.

User interface – cancel creation of repeatable blocks

Cancel function in repeatable blocks of flexible part did not function properly.

Use of the Query Tool plug-in – Oracle exception

Query tool indexer: Oracle Exception ORA-12899: value too large for column. The query tool indexer hanged on indexing documents and the server log file contained an exception.

Use of the translated HelpSystem plug-ins – Freetext templates

Freetext template buttons were not available if the system language was not English

Java compatibility - File selection

IUCLID 5 file selection did not work with Java Version 1.6.0_12. This bug affected IUCLID 5.1 and the CSR plug-in.

Export / import – Creation of empty repeatable blocks

Empty repeatable blocks were created after an export / import cycle in endpoints. When exporting and re-importing an endpoint, which had either been created or modified in IUCLID 5, the import XML transformation added one empty element to a repeatable block that did not contain any data. If the endpoint was loaded in IUCLID afterwards, these empty blocks were displayed.

User interface – background jobs monitor

On import or export process the background jobs monitor items was difficult to read. The items were always vertically centered and therefore the positioning changed on every background item job creation. Background jobs are now displayed from top to bottom.

Use of the Query Tool plug-in

Query Tool user Interface: Input was truncated if IUCLID 5 used a comma as decimal separator.

Use of the Query Tool plug-in

Query Tool user Interface: an exception was produced if IUCLID 5 used a comma as decimal separator and one entered a decimal value with a comma in the Query Tool interface.

Improvements

User interface – Window Title

The IUCLID 5 Window Title is now configurable to differentiate two different IUCLID installations.
