1. Introduction

This document provides a description of the installation procedure of the IUCLID 5.2 CSR tool plug-in.

The Chemical Safety Report (CSR) generator plug-in (CSR plug-in) captures information from IUCLID 5 records and applies rules that enable the automatic generation of a CSR RTF or XML document, which may serve as starter for the CSR.

A more detailed User Manual is available for this tool on the IUCLID 5 website.

2. How to download the CSR tool Plug-in

Open your internet browser, for example Internet Explorer and follow the steps hereafter:

- Go to the IUCLID 5 download website <http://iuclid.eu>;
- Log into the restricted area of the download website using your previously created account and use your username and password;
- In the “Download” section select “Version 5.2.0”;
- Then go to the subsection ‘CSR Plugin’
- Click “Download the installation package”;
- Select the “I acknowledge” check box and then click “Next” button;
- In order to download the software you have to accept the license agreement. Read carefully the Licence Agreement and, if you agree, accept it selecting both the “I accept” and “I am entitled to sign this License agreement” checkboxes. Click the “Next” button. Select “please click here” to start the download. Select “Save” to save the file to your computer;
- Save the **iuclid5_plugin_csr_2010-07-09.zip** file to your computer.
- Extract the CSR tool plug-in **eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip** from **iuclid5_plugin_csr_2010-07-09.zip** file that you downloaded. Use **eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip** file for the rest of the installation (i.e. do not extract the content of this zip file).
- To complete the installation, follow the “Standalone installation” or the “Distributed installation” section of this document.

3. Installation instructions

Pre-condition: IUCLID release 5.2 installed on your computer

The plugin consists in a client side ZIP file called:

- eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip

The installation of the plugin depends on your IUCLID 5 installation:

- workstation / stand-alone version or
- distributed version

3.1. Workstation / Standalone Installation

If IUCLID 5 is running, save your work and close the application.

- Copy the file “**eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip**” into the **plugins\client** folder you find inside the **IUCLID5-folder**.

If you have installed the IUCLID 5 stand-alone software in the folder:

C:\IUCLID5

You will find the sub-folder:

C:\IUCLID5\plugins\client (folder for the client side plugins)

To activate the plugin it will be sufficient to copy the file into the specific folder.

Important:

Do not extract the ZIP files!

Depending on your computer setting the file name may be displayed without extension (.zip).

Copy the file	eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip
into the folder	<IUCLID5-folder>\plugins\client
Sample	C:\IUCLID5\plugins\client\ eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip
Hint	In the folder you will already find files like: clientExtensionPointRootPlugin.zip eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.helpsystemEN.zip eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.xform.zip

- Restart IUCLID 5.
- The CSR tool plug-in is installed and ready to use.

Note:

If the plug-in is no longer required, the **eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip** file can be removed. The plug-in will then disappear from the IUCLID 5 application.

3.2. Distributed Installation

The server application does not need to be stopped for this installation.

You will find the following sub-folder on your IUCLID 5 application server:

...\\i5clientPlugins\\remotePlugins (folder for the client side plugins)

Important:

Do not extract the ZIP files!

Depending on your computer setting the file name may be displayed without extension (.zip).

- Copy the file **eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip** into the ...\\i5clientPlugins\\remotePlugins folder, for example **C:\\Program Files\\apache-tomcat-5.5.20\\webapps\\i5server\\i5clientPlugins\\remotePlugins**

To activate the plugin it will be sufficient to copy the file into the specific folder.

Copy the file	eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip
into the folder	<IUCLID5 WebApp-folder> \\i5clientPlugins\\remotePlugins
Sample	C:\\Program Files\\apache-tomcat-5.5.20\\webapps\\i5server\\i5clientPlugins\\remotePlugins\\ eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip
Hint	In the folder you will already find files like: clientExtensionPointRootPlugin.zip eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.helpsystemEN.zip eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.xform.zip

- Restart IUCLID 5 client application. The server does not need to be restarted.

The new plug-in will only be accessible after the client IUCLID 5 application has been restarted.

Note:

If the plug-in is no longer required, the **eu.echa.iuclid.plugin.csr.zip** file can be removed. The plug-in will then disappear from the IUCLID 5 application.

3.3. Checking for a Successful Installation

If the installation was successful, the CSR tool plug-in should be added to the task panel, the toolbar and also the menu (“Plugins | CSR tool”).

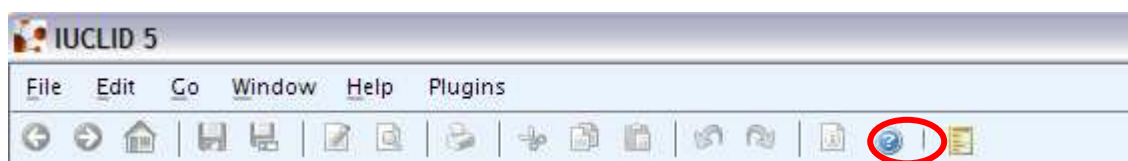
4. Create a CSR with IUCLID

Step1: start IUCLID and login. The plug-in will appear on the task panel.

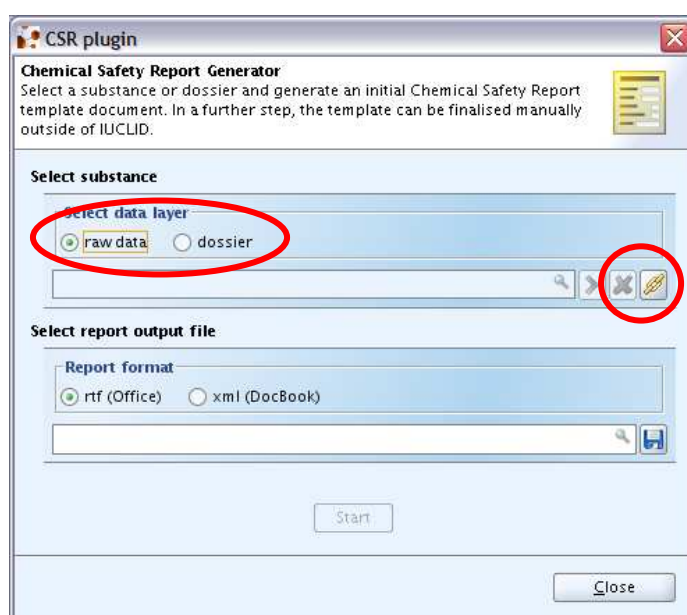
Note: Additionally the plugin can be run on a substance or dossier by performing a right-click on the entry in the result list. This will pre select the source to be used for the CSR generation.



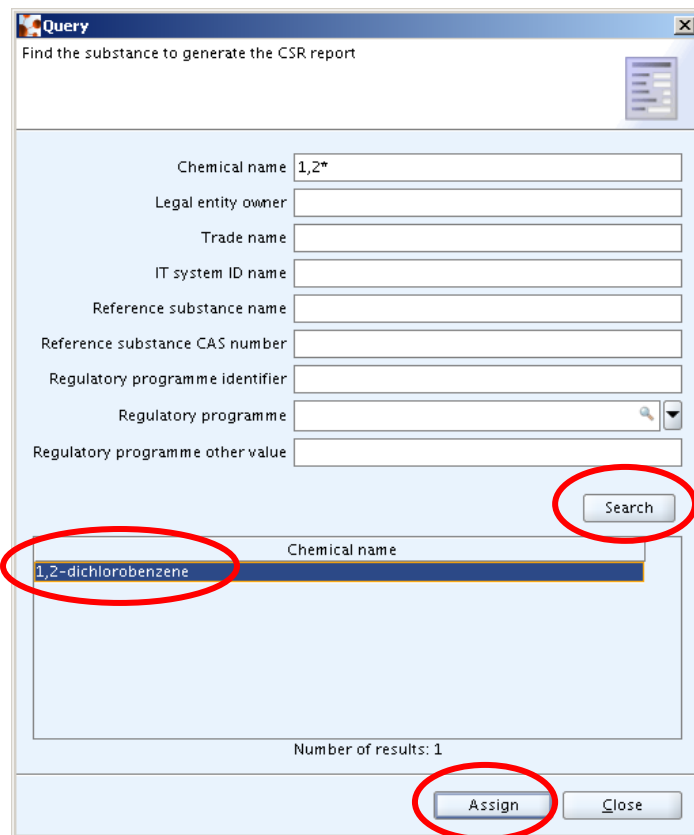
Start alternative: Use the task bar button to launch the plugin.



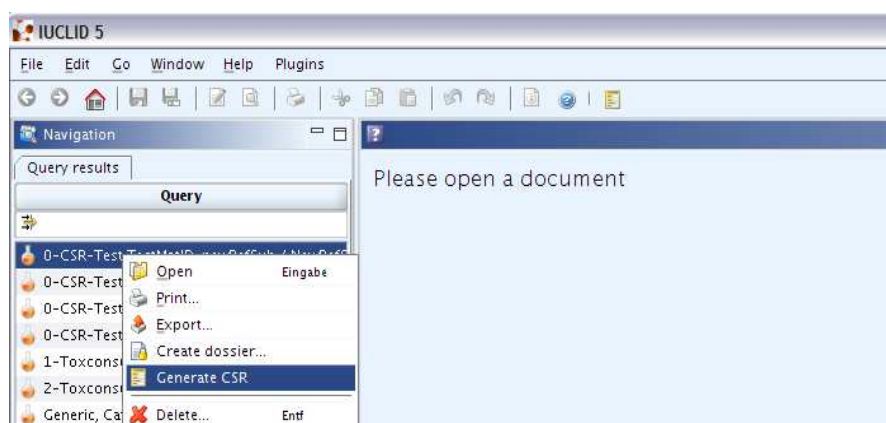
Step 2: launch the plug-in by clicking on 'Run' or on the plug-in icon and select the source of data you want to use as a basis for your Chemical Safety Report (raw data / substance or dossier data):



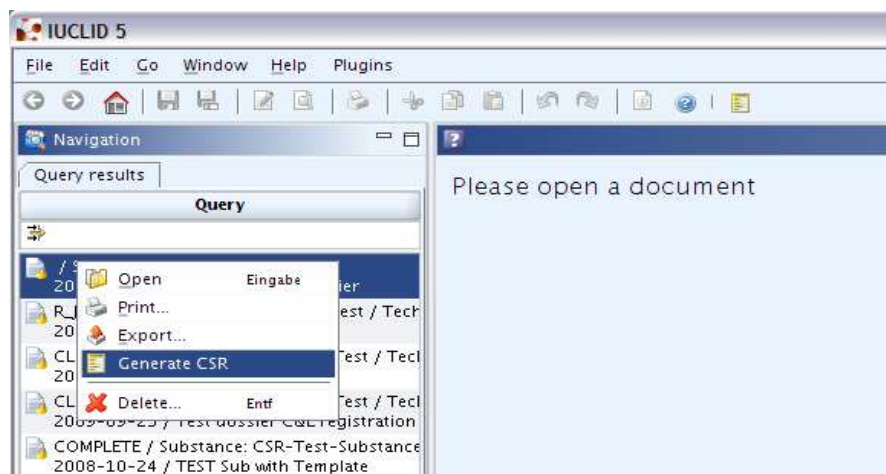
Step 3: select a substance or a dossier (depending on the source of data selected at the previous step):



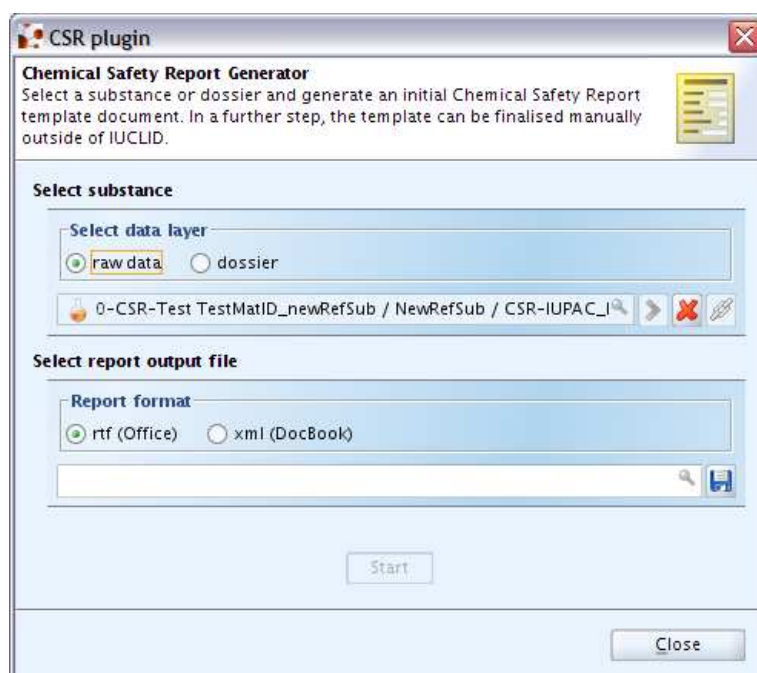
As an alternative to steps 2 and 3 you can also open a substance or dossier result list (i.e. Substance --> Update or Dossier -->View) and right-click on the respective entry. Example for a substance dataset:



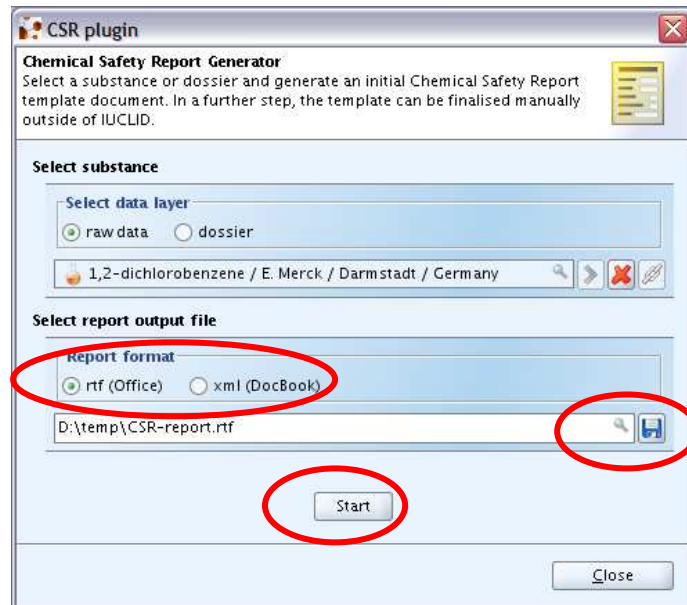
Example for a dossier:



As result the entry and the respective data layer will be pre selected in the tool:

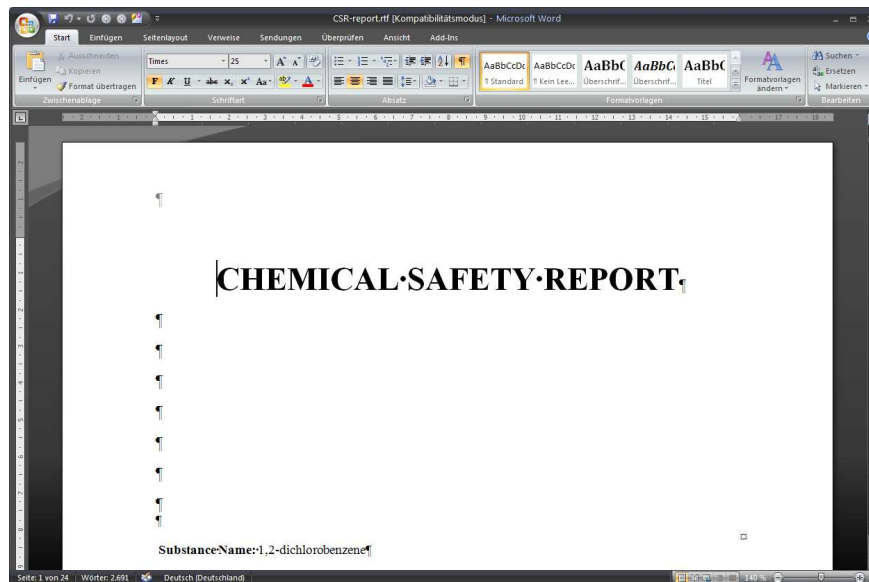


Step 4: select RTF as the target format, enter a valid file name and press “Start” to generate the CSR report.



The IUCLID 5 client will wait until the report generation is finished.

As result you will find an RTF file in the specified output folder. Open this file with a word processing application like MS Word. Press “CTRL + a” to select the whole document content and press F9 afterwards to update page number references (in MS Word).



5. Documentation Available

In addition a comprehensive user manual can be downloaded in the Documentation section of the IUCLID 5 website. It provides insight into the kind of information the CSR plugin extracts from IUCLID 5 data sets or dossiers and the principal rules underlying the automatic generation of an initial CSR document. It also gives tips on how to minimise the amount of manual revision required to a CSR document by optimising the data entry in its IUCLID 5 source data set.

5.1. Licensing

The License Agreement acknowledged during the download of the original software applies to this release, according to the relevant paragraph:

"Software" shall mean a computer software system named "IUCLID 5" to collect, store and exchange with others data on chemical substances, their properties, their producers or importers and related data and meta data. The use of the Software is not restricted to a specific national, regional or international legal requirement. The Software means also all of the contents of the files (provided either by electronic download, on physical media or any other method of distribution), disk(s), CD-ROM(s) or other media with which this Agreement is provided, **as well as any updated versions of the above-mentioned computer software.**
